

THE PREVALENCE OF JOB SATISFACTION AMONG EMPLOYEES OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE LIBYAN YOUTH VARIABLE AND ITS RELATIONSHIP TO GENDER

***Abstract_** The study aimed to detect the prevalence of job satisfaction among the members of the staff of the National Youth Council of Libya - Tripoli, and to identify differences in the degree of job satisfaction have depending on the variable Gender (male, female), and to achieve the objectives of the study applied the tool of (a measure of job satisfaction), and so on a sample of (30) employees, and use descriptive analytical method, and the study found mixed results represented in proportion (30%) are dissatisfied with their jobs, and the proportion (67%) satisfied with their jobs moderately, and the proportion (03%) satisfied with their jobs high degree, as the study found the lack of significant differences were statistically significant in job satisfaction among the staff of the Council.*
