THE FIVE FACTORS OF PERSONALITY AND ITS RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN LONELINESS DIVORCED WOMEN IN SAUDI SOCIETY

ABSTRACT_ this study aims at recognize the relationship between The five factors of personality and loneliness for divorced women in Saudi society In light of some of the variables, moreover To achieve study objectives, the researcher selected a sample of divorced, a (180) female, For the purpose of the study, the researcher used two questionnaires; questionnaire for five factors of personality, and loneliness questionnaire. Means, weight means, standard deviation were computed by using t- test. Variance analysis, percentages and correlation coefficients were also calculated. The results revealed the following: Results of the study show a there is a positive correlation between neuroticism and loneliness. There is a negative correlation between loneliness and Extraversion, Openness, Agreeableness, Conscientiousness. The results did not appear statistically significant differences depending on the variables in the study on five factors of personality, and loneliness questionnaire. In the light of the results there were some useful recommendations.
